You can get an i-go card if you:

- Are 0-25 years old
- Live or receive education in East Sussex; and have special needs or a disability. This includes learning difficulties, physical disabilities and autism
- A diagnosis isn't necessary

Arrival

- The main front door is manual, but is wheelchair accessible

General Space

- The floors inside are smooth
- Most areas are suitable height for wheelchair users

Toilets & Changing Rooms

- We have a large, step free, accessible toilet with handrails
- We do not have any changing rooms at this site
- We have a baby changing mat

Stairs, Steps and Lifts

- We have an accessible lift which can take people to all levels of the building

Noise & Lights

- There should be no extra or unexpected noises or lights

Food & Drink

- We allow people with special dietary requirements to bring their own food
