We offer i-go scheme concessionary discounts at our leisure centres and swimming pools.

Show your i-go card to reception at Downs Leisure Centre to receive concessionary rates*; Dino's Soft Play: £2.95, Gym Session: £3.85*, plus get one carer in for free.

**Concessionary gym session price is subject to a £19.95 joining fee. Minimum age 14 unless accessing gym via fit families or t45 programme. Contact centre for an induction.*

An i-go card gives you discounts and accessibility information at leisure centres, attractions, activities and clubs in East Sussex.

You can get an i-go card if you:

- Are 0-25 years old
- Live or receive education in East Sussex; and have special needs or a disability. This includes learning difficulties, physical disabilities and autism.
- A diagnosis isn't necessary

Arrival

- Accessible car park which offers 5 disabled car parking spaces at the front of the building
- There is a dropped curb in front of the spaces. There is also a dropped curb in front of the double blue doors
- The main front door is automatic. A swing gate is located at reception to enter the building
- If you need assistance to gain entry via the swing gate, please ask at reception

Reception

- Large print timetables and leaflets available on request
- Lowered reception counter
- Hearing Loop

General Space

- The floors inside are smooth
- Most areas are suitable height for wheelchair users

(*Concessions: Junior (gym sessions), Disabled, i-go card, Universal Credit, Employment and Support Allowance, Pension Credit or Job Seeker's Allowance (Proof of entitlement required on admission.)

Toilets & Changing Rooms

- We have an accessible toilet with hand dryer and emergency cord
- We have one changing room with a toilet – hand dryers, handrails, pull down seats & emergency cord
- Radar key only needed for changing room. This is available upon request at reception if needed

Stairs, Steps and Lifts/Outdoor Areas

- The stairs leading to the balcony have a handrail
- Access to the all-weather football pitch via path and outdoor seating is wheelchair accessible

Noise & Lights

- Flashing lights during certain sessions such as Roller Disco & selected indoor cycling. Please check with reception
- Fire alarms are tested weekly during opening hours, please contact the centre for more information
- A tannoy system is used in the centre and Dino's soft play
- Dino's soft play will sometimes have music playing inside

Food & Drink

- We have an onsite cafe with large print menus available at request
- We allow people with special dietary requirements to bring their own food
- Assistance with bringing food to tables is available if needed
